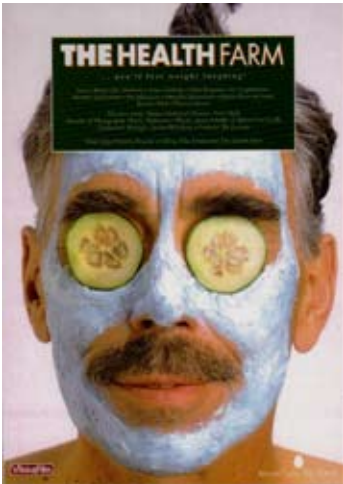

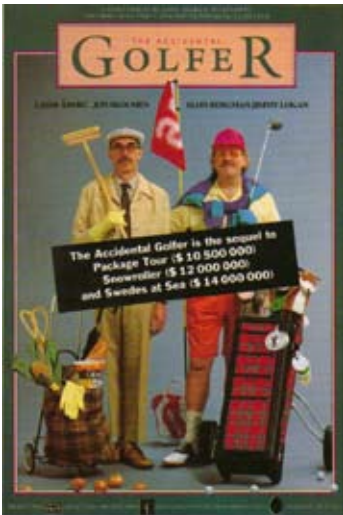
Tagline: *Facepacks and Colonics, The Swedes were first*
